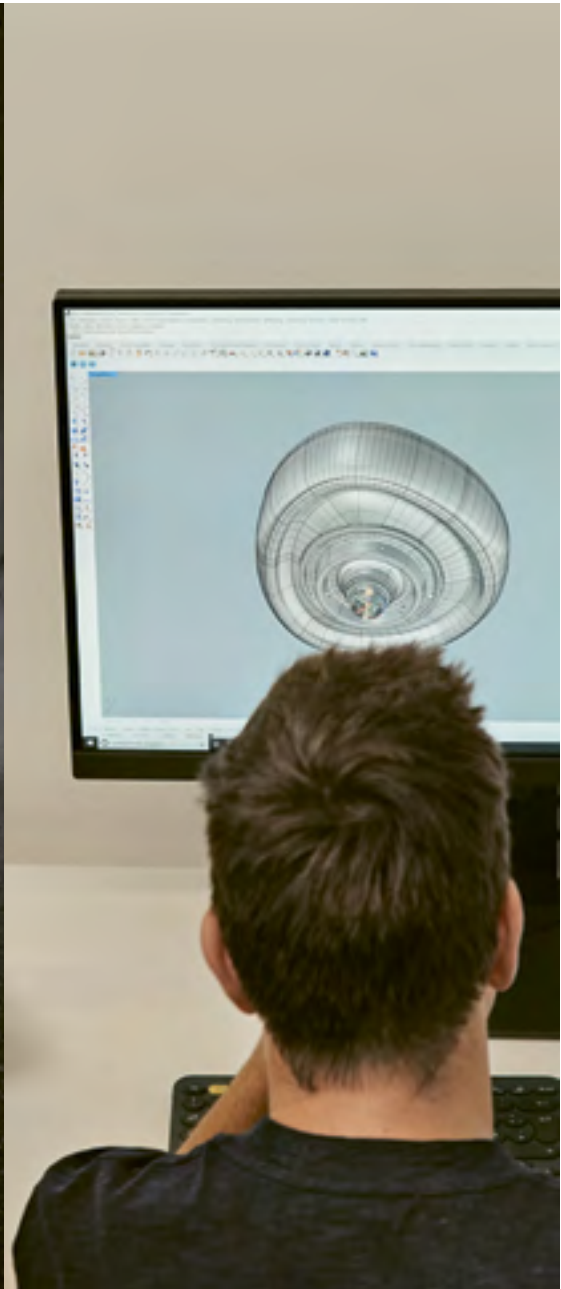
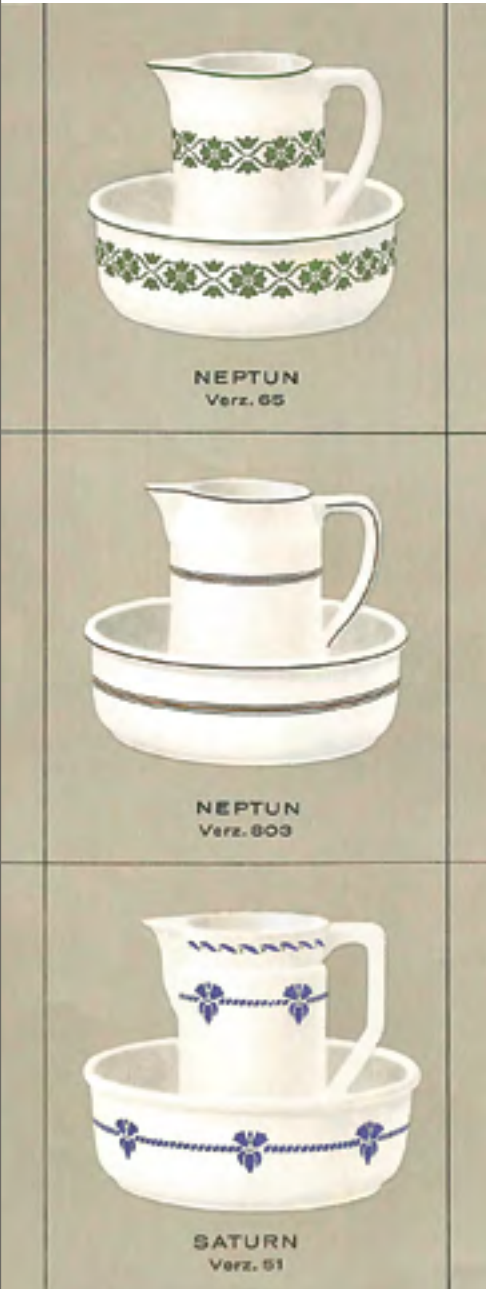
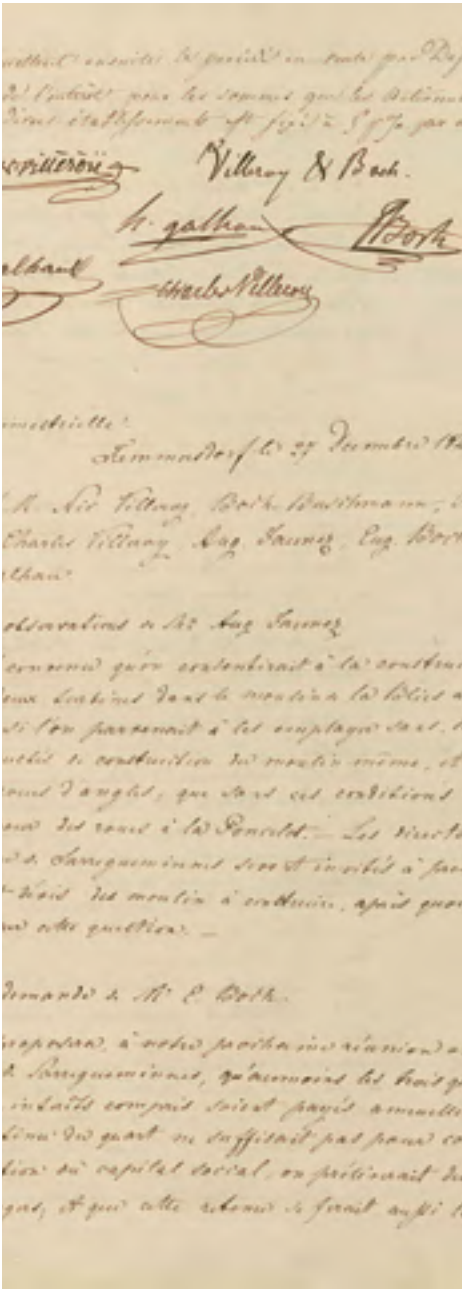
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ROOTED IN PROGRESS

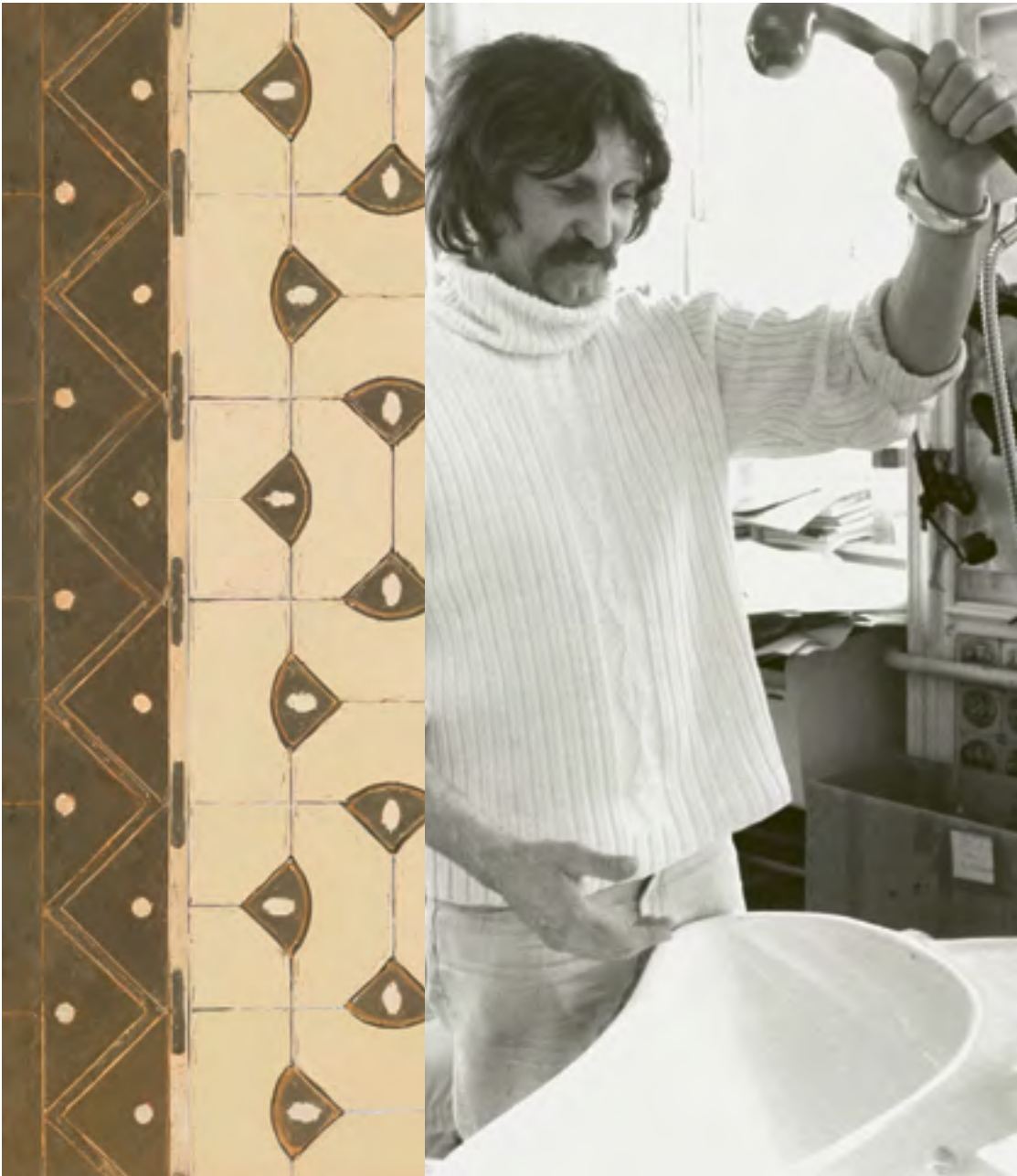

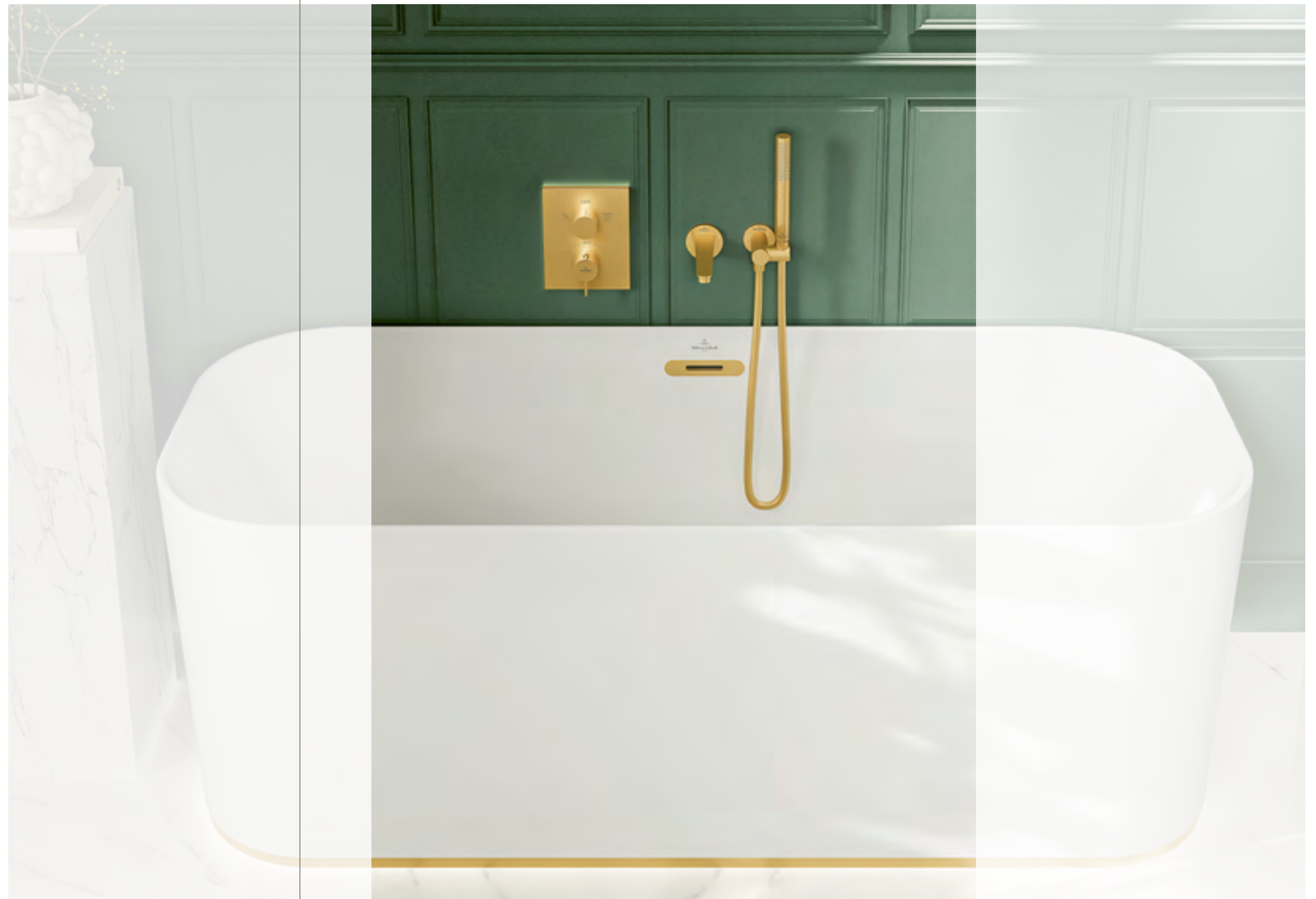

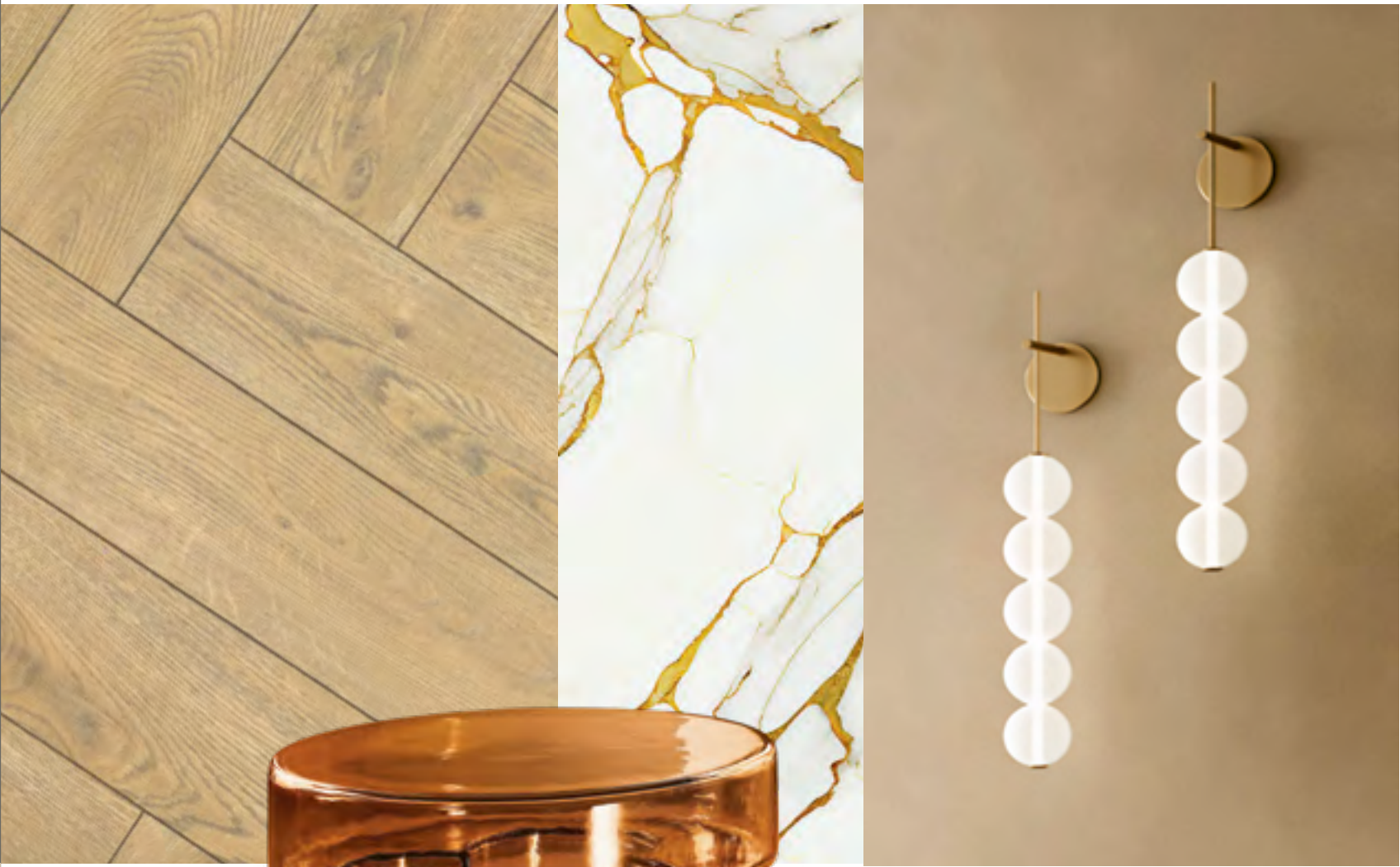

URBAN CLARITY

This style follows the principles of minimalism. But it involves more than mere reduction — the focus is on geometric forms, clean lines and a cool overall aesthetic. Each design element is chosen with care. Concrete, chrome and glass are welcome complements. The full spectrum of grey shades lends a signature look to floors, walls and even bathroom ceramics.

LOOK: MINIMALISM

This look forgoes details to create an atmosphere of calm and clarity. A true study in the art of minimalism: Forms are plain and geometric, colours are discreet and decorative elements are used sparingly. Tap fittings and accessories in matt finishes such as Matt Black underscore the air of calm.

Straight-lined and succinct: The design of the Squaro Infinity shower tray together with the Conum shower fitting.

Thin-walled with a delicate air: The washbasins from the Memento 2.0 collection, here in combination with the Conum tap fitting.

LOOK: ALL BLACK

The key to All Black lies in its bold realisation. When walls, furniture, accessories and ceramics feature a deep, matt black finish, All Black acquires a particularly imposing elegance, with no need for any special effects.

An almost sculptural presence: The free-standing Theano Curved bath with the Conum tap fitting.

Ceramics, textiles and wallpaper — different black materials in combination make this look so alluring. It becomes even more elegant when additional elements such as dark wood or leather come into play. Accessories in chrome or brass can lend the look an additional touch of extravagance.



Home accessories such as a wooden stool or an upholstered bench add a harmonious sense of balance.

Black need not be monochrome: Marbled tiles and patterned wallpaper provide for variety.

Furniture and wall coverings featuring refined finishes underscore the exclusive character.

Matt or gently textured stone or concrete surfaces harmonise perfectly with black.

Astutely positioned lamps really come into their own in combination with All Black.

Dark wood for an even more luxurious homely flair.

Just made for tone-in-tone mixed patterns: Tiles in terrazzo look.

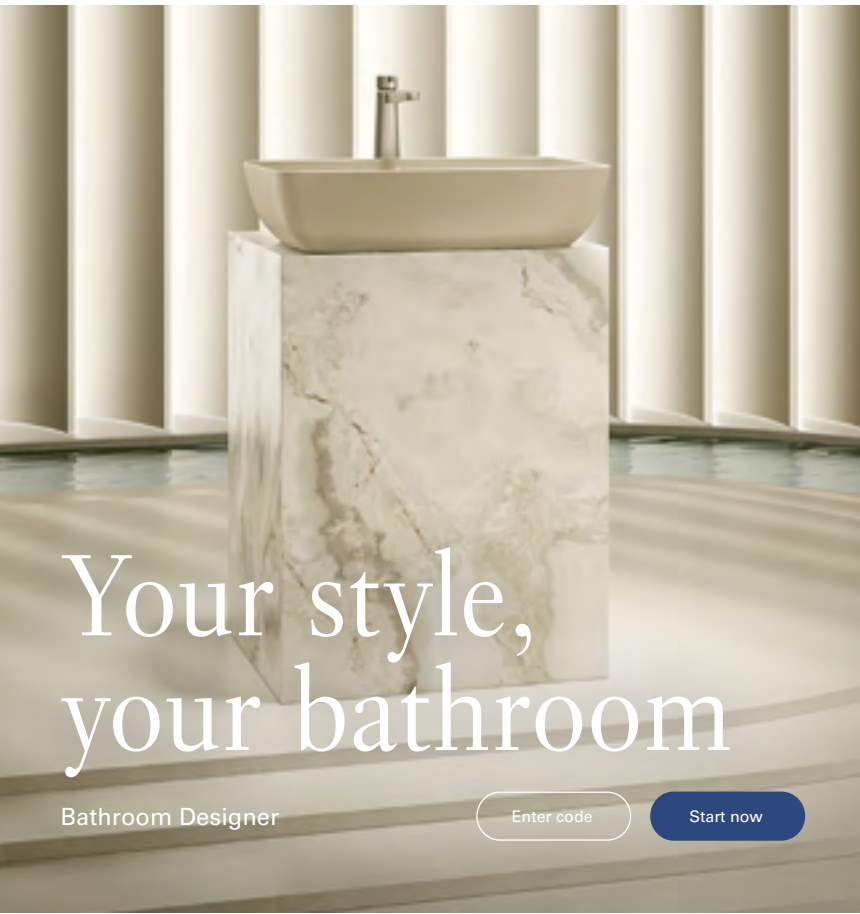
